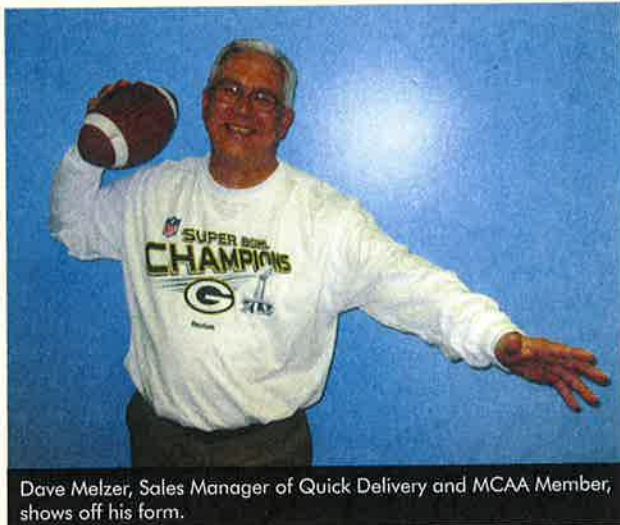


Faces in the Crowd

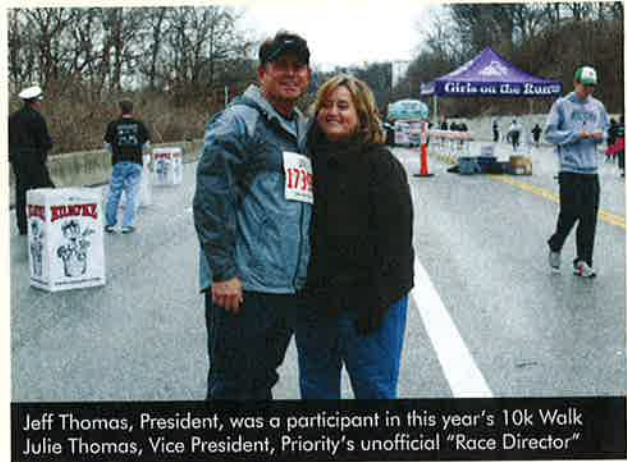
After meeting at the MCAA Convention in 2010, Quick Delivery partnered with Terry Knutson of Corporate Courier in Eau Claire, WI, in this event.

It's the largest non-professional sporting event in Cincinnati! This year nineteen thousand people ran and walked in the 2011 American Heart Mini-Marathon, held Sunday, March 20, 2011. Our contribution is to pick up and deliver all the items necessary for race day. This includes cones, tables, wheelchairs, bananas, generators, you name it, and we deliver it! After the last runner crosses the finish line, our team picks it all back up and returns everything Monday morning.
